YCONNECT

A dedicated space to showcase the youth-led efforts driving the Y-ACT Project.

Co-financed by the European Union (CERV-DAPHNE), led by Amref Italy, and partnered with Le Reseau Association, National Coordination of New Italian Generations (CoNNGI), and University of Milan Bicocca, the Y-ACT Project aims to prevent and combat Female Genital Mutilation (FGM) in Italy.

FGM is recognized as a violation of human rights and a form of gender-based violence that deeply affects girls and women at individual, social, sexual, and health levels.

The Y-ACT Project involves direct engagement with youth from migrant backgrounds and members of target communities to create community-centered interventions.

Activities include training and empowering young leaders, fostering intergenerational dialogue, and raising awareness within communities.

The 2020-2025 Gender Strategy highlights the need to address gender stereotypes by focusing on youth engagement. The Y-ACT Project identifies young people as powerful entry points to drive awareness and behavioral change within communities, ensuring sustainable transformation from within.


TRADITION

PROJECT ACTIVITIES

The Y-ACT Project spans Rome, Milan, Turin, and Padua, with the following key activities:

- Youth Empowerment, Engagement & Activation: Youth Leaders from each region participate in tailored empowerment and activation programs.
- Community Engagement & Activation: Members of target communities form 4 Communities of Practice (CoPs) to address community health concerns.
- Intergenerational Dialogue and Behavioral Change: Communities are activated through collective action to challenge the social acceptance of FGM.
- Advocating for Girls' Rights: Promoting health, security, physical integrity, and self-determination for girls through exchanges, events, campaigns, and social media activities.
- **Final Event:** A closing event in Brussels will present the project's outcomes to stakeholders, institutions, and activists, fostering the exchange of best practices.
